

OAKFIELD CONSERVATION CLUB RULES

~NOTE: Rules are set up by Club Directors, for all club members to obey by when using club property.

Club property locations:

FARM # 1

North West of Oakfield
Hwy 151 & Thill Rd.

FARM #2

South East of Oakfield
On River Rd.



RULES AS FOLLOWED:

- 1) Club property is for club members only.
(No Guest/ No Exceptions)
- 2) When entering club property, you are to place your window tag in the window of your vehicle, where it is visible. (Not on vehicle seat or floor.)
*FYI – Any vehicle found on club property with no window tag will be checked by record of license plate #.
- 3) No club member shall give their window tag to a friend to use. (If they wish to use club property, memberships are available to be bought.)
- 4) Be ready to show your membership if asked. Your membership should be carried with you at all times when on club property.
- 5) All young adults using club property must have their own membership or be accompanied by their parent, whom has a membership.
- 6) Any one found on club property that is NOT a member, is trespassing.
-They could be prosecuted for trespassing.
-They will be asked to buy a membership or leave the property.
- 7) No gas motors allowed in Lake Allen. (Electric motors will be allowed) No hunting on island or within 25 feet and no cutting of trees for tree stands.
- 8) No permanent tree stands allowed on club property. Stands must be portable, to be setup by one person. And have owner's name and address on it. ALL stands must be removed at end of season.
- 9) No ATV's or Snowmobiles allowed on Club property.
(ATV's will be allowed, only if needed, during workdays or clean-up.)
- 10) For your safety we ask that you wear some type of orange when hunting upland game birds.
- 11) Remember, when shooting, there are farm buildings near our club property.
Do not shoot towards these buildings!
- 12) Please treat club property as if it is your own and pick-up after yourself before leaving club property.
- 13) Know the property; the club is not responsible for you trespassing on neighboring properties.
